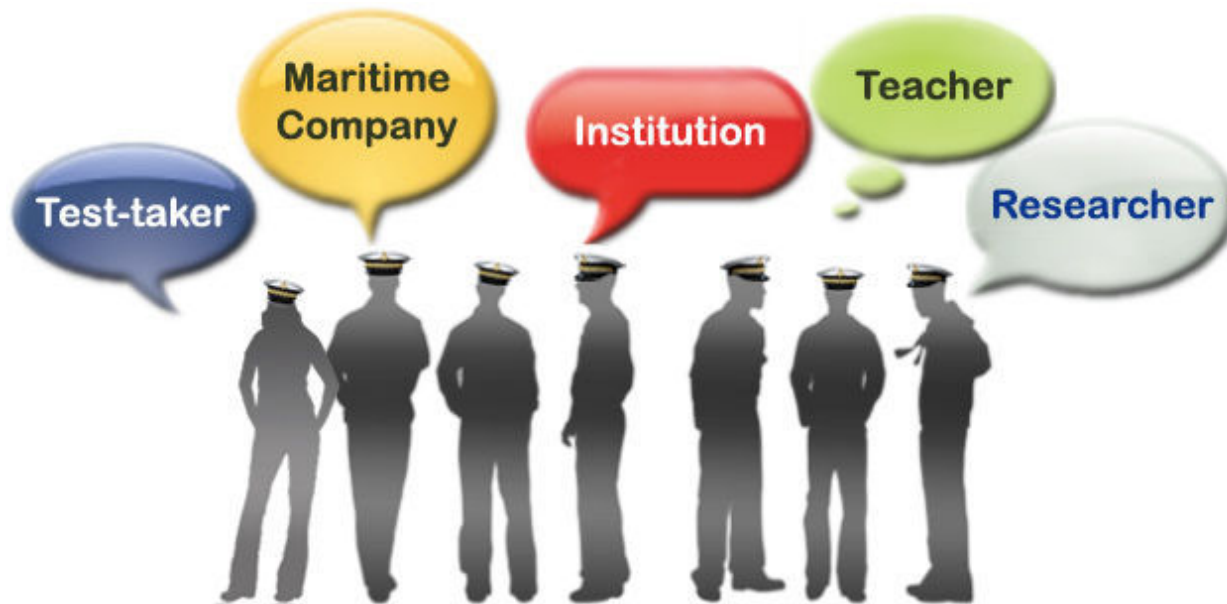

**MarTEL** stands for 'The International Standards for Maritime English' developed through the support of the European Union's Leonardo Lifelong Learning Programme. **MarTEL** has been designed to test mariners' Maritime English through a series of online tests designed to cater for seafarers of different ranks and types.

There are three different phases:

- **Phase 1** - Cadet level
- **Phase 2** - Officer level
- **Phase 3** - Senior Officer Level

At **Phases 2 and 3** the testing is split into **two** categories: **Deck officers** and **Marine Engineering Officers**. This is necessary due to the diversity between the occupations and the level of skills needed for each role.

**Each Phase** consists of

- Test
- Study Guidelines
- Study Unit
- Teacher's handbook

Each standard has been **approved by BTEC/EDEXCEL**

Test takers who pass their test will receive an EDEXCEL certificate to certify that they are competent to a specific level in Maritime English and thus able to communicate sufficiently onboard a ship with a multinational crew. This will help to reduce the large number of accidents at sea caused by poor communication.

**MarTEL** is at the forefront of research in the field of Maritime English but is always looking to find new ways to improve. The standards have incorporated research by top Maritime English experts as well as their own **MarTEL** team of researchers.
